ORDER

In exercise of the power conferred by Section 140 of the West Bengal Panchayat Act, 1973 read with Sections 16 & 17 of the West Bengal Panchayat Elections Act, 2003 read with Rules 26 & 27 of the West Bengal Panchayat Elections Rules, 2006, the West Bengal State Election Commission hereby publishes the Draft Order for Delimitation of Dakshin Dinajpur Zilla Parishad Constituencies and Reservation of Seats thereto for Panchayat General Elections, 2023. The Block(s) have been specified in column (1) of the Schedule below (hereinafter referred to as the said Schedule), the number of members to be elected to the Zilla Parishad has been specified in the corresponding entries in column (2), the area of the Block has been divided into constituencies as specified in the corresponding entries in column (3), the constituency or constituencies reserved for the Scheduled Tribes (ST), the Scheduled Castes (SC) or the Backward Classes (BC) have been determined as specified in the corresponding entries in column (4) and the constituency or constituencies reserved for Women (W) have been determined as specified in the corresponding entries in column (5) of the said Schedule.

The draft will be taken up for consideration after fifteen days from this day and any objection or suggestion with respect thereto, which may be received by the State Election Commissioner within the said period, shall be duly considered.
